

Hobstar Preview: December, 2013



American Brilliant Emerald-Clear Cut Glass 2 Piece Punch Bowl. 16" tall, 14" rim diameter.

"An Odd Little Compote," by LindaJo Hare presents a small squat comport that is cut as usual on the underside, but also features a fully cut hobstar on the interior of the bowl. There are photo examples of this item in Revi where it is wrongly identified as "Princeton by Libbey." Also wrong is the description in Boggess Identifying as "Princeton" by Liberty."
