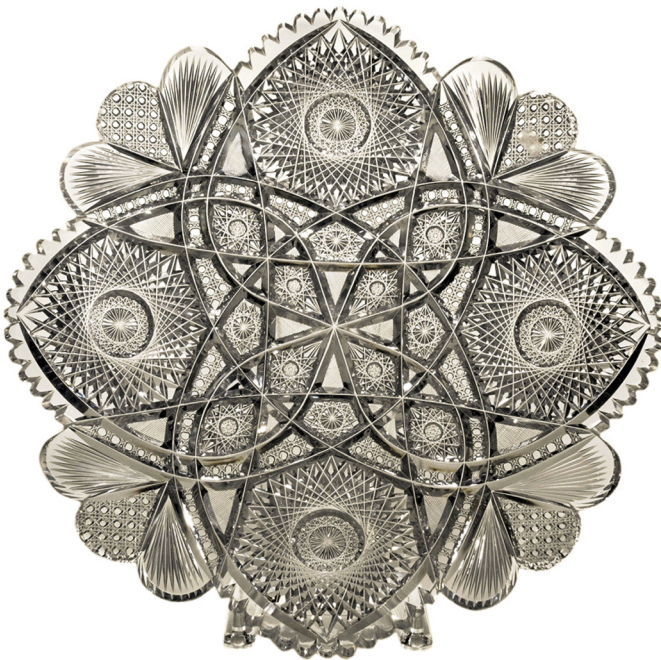


## Hobstar Preview: October, 2014

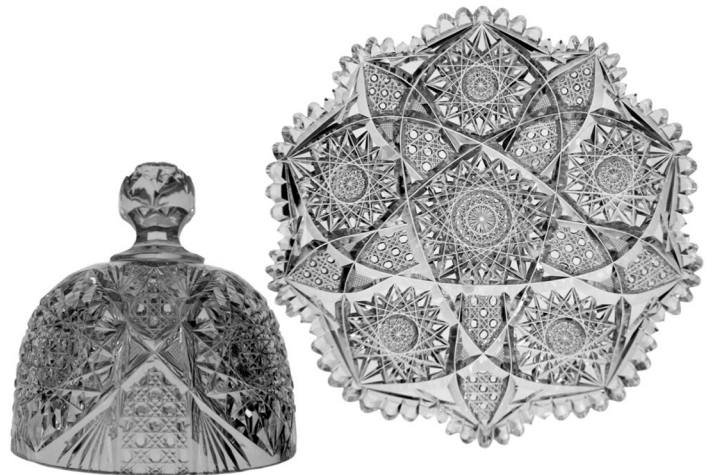
"Brunk Auction Results," by Fred Coveler reports that this 16" tray sold for \$8,400 at the Brunk Auction

in Asheville, NC 9/12/14. The tray is cut in the same pattern as the three-part punch bowl on p.184 in Rarities.



"DuMouchelles Art Gallery Auction Results," Fred Coveler reports that the above-pictured punch set sold for an astounding \$132,000. Included are a Dorflinger **Montrose** green cut-to-clear 14" punchbowl, 13 matching cups and the ladle.

A Turkish ("Hookah") style coffee pot, cut in the **Harvard** pattern, 15" tall sold for \$39,000. A signed Hawkes two-part 14 1/2" dia. punchbowl in the lovely **Queens** pattern, sold with 12 matching cups for \$20,400.
