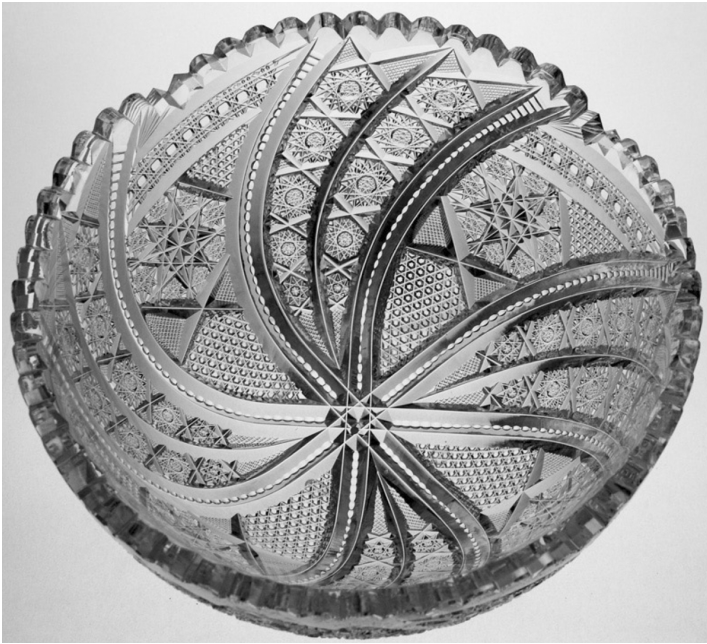


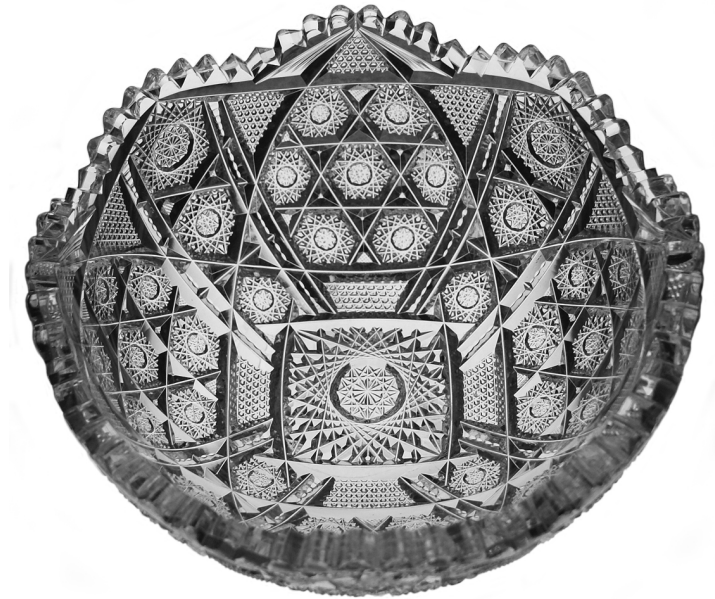
## The Hobstar Preview: February 2015
